

POLICY – CLUB UNIFORMS

Purpose

This policy is intended to ensure a consistent club image.

Definitions

Club Uniform – the jersey, shorts, and socks issued by Burnaby Girls Soccer Club (BGSC).

League Game - any regular season game.

Cup Game - any game that is part of a cup competition organized by the BCSA, a league, or a district.

Regular Season - the time period from September through March when league games are scheduled.

Background

The Club Uniform is the most recognizable part of branding BGSC and, therefore, is considered a valuable asset to the club. Furthermore, the consistent use of club uniforms recognizes the efforts of club volunteers that are necessary for the operation of the club.

Policy

All BGSC teams are required to wear the Club Uniform for League Games, Cup Games, and during Regular Season play. BGSC recommends that the Club Uniform be worn for tournament play but will allow alternate uniforms to be worn; the alternate uniforms would be purchased at team expense and must be approved by the BGSC Executive Board.

Procedures
